

**CAMBRIA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
FULL TEXT OF MEASURE P-06**

The Board of Directors shall not authorize the extension of water service except nonpotable water for agricultural and irrigation purposes for outside of the District boundaries, as the boundaries exist at the enactment of this ordinance, for residential, industrial, or commercial purposes without first completing environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act or its successor statute, amending the Water Master Plan, and then submitting the question for approval to the voters of the District. The property owner seeking water service will pay the costs of the application and election in advance.

IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS OF MEASURE P-06

The Board of Directors of the Cambria Community Services District, "CCSD", has placed this measure on the ballot for consideration by Cambria voters. If adopted, it enacts a law that can only be amended or repealed by a vote of the registered voters. This law will prohibit the extension of potable water services outside the current CCSD boundaries without environmental review, an amendment to the Water Master Plan, and a majority vote of the registered voters of Cambria. Any person who applies for an extension of potable water service will be required to pay, in advance, the cost of the processing and election. This law may not be amended or repealed by the Board of the CCSD.

ARGUMENT IN FAVOR OF MEASURE P-06

Measure P-06 will protect Cambria's sensitive environment from uncontrolled growth by placing the power to approve the expansion of water services beyond the current Cambria Community Services District boundaries in the hands of the voters of Cambria.
