Pursuant to Elections Code Section 13313, the attached materials pertaining to Measure A-16 on the March 8, 2016 Special Election are hereby submitted for 10-day public examination. During the 10-day examination period provided by this section, any voter of the jurisdiction in which the election is being held may seek a writ of mandate or injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted. The writ of mandate or injunction request shall be filed not later than the end of the 10-calendar-day public examination A peremptory writ of mandate or an injunction shall be issued only upon clear and convincing proof that the material in question is false, misleading, or inconsistent with the requirements of the Elections Code, and that issuance of the writ or injunction will not substantially interfere with the printing or distribution of the official election materials as provided by law.

Rebuttal to Argument in Favor of Measure A

Measure A is a Tax and Spend Measure! Voting for Measure A will guarantee a brand new bloated bureaucratic government agency to tax you, have the authority to put a meter on your well and charge you "extraction fees" for every drop of water you pump.

Don't fall for the false promise of local control! This proposed district only covers a portion of the basin. It strains credulity that the County would passively stand by and let the State step in and take over our water.
