



Adult Housing

Adult Residential Care Facility

- 133 Individuals served
- 33,340 bed days paid

Institutions for Mental Disease

- 35 Individuals served
- 9,336 bed days paid

Unmet Needs

- 66 Individuals served by our County Behavioral Health Department need Adult Residential Care but currently are not living in an ARF.

Unmet Need:

Adequate number of Resource Family Homes

Short Term Residential Treatment Programs (STRTPs)

- **One STRTP in SLO County, TMHA's Youth Treatment Program (YTP)**
- **Zero children from other counties have been placed in YTP**
- **21 children placed in out of county STRTPs**

Community Program Planning Process

- Quarterly Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Advisory Committee meetings held in-person and virtually
- 73 individuals participated
- Input is shared with the BH Director by including them in monthly MHSA Leadership meetings, quarterly MHSA Advisory Committee meetings, and through shared reports and updates
- Goal for fiscal year 2023-2024:

Increase engagement and representation by increasing participation of youth, LGBTQ+, and individuals with disabilities
