Mental Health Advisory Committee (MAC) Stakeholder Group Meeting:

This document is proof of stakeholder involvement in decision making priorities and practices for the County of San Luis Obispo Mental Health Services Act programs.

The MAC Stakeholder Group asserts that they have fully understood and made a decision regarding the changes for the following program/service:

Justification: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In order to help meet the DHCS and CalMHSA goals of successful CalAIM implementation, the County seeks to provide one-year of fiscal support for Medi-Cal organizations. MHSA funds have been identified as a tool which can support incentives and strategies to assist in CalAIM infrastructure. One of the key CalAIM reforms is the ability for counties to both increase Medi-Cal rates and collect revenue which can be spent on community programs. In future years, Medi-Cal “investments” may support MHSA programs which could be impacted by reforms, or expanded if no MHSA dollars are available. The County has launched a new MHSA-funded electronic health record system, Smart Care, which will enhance Medi-Cal revenue. This year will be critical for organizations like TMHA, Family Care Network, and Seneca to establish SmartCare and train staff to maximize Medi-Cal billing and productivity. The County will offer 2-3% increases in quarterly contract amounts to support productivity measures and procedure enhancements which increase Medi-Cal revenue. Provide further improvements to be implemented next FY.
