This document is proof of stakeholder involvement in decision making priorities and practices for the County of San Luis Obispo Mental Health Services Act programs.

The MAC Stakeholder Group asserts that they have fully understood and made a decision regarding the changes for the following program/service:

Community Services and Supports – LPT Homeless Services Project

<b>Justification:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The County has identified a need to expand its planning for outreach and medical engagements with unhoused individuals within its CAT and Bridge Housing programs. This includes a need for training for med managers and others in working with unhoused clients as the Department prepares for expanded outreach operations.</li> <li>At the same time, the County has an opportunity to reassign an LPT with extensive outreach experience in working with unhoused, mentally ill, and SUD-affected clients for a short period while another medication manager is able to backfill a caseload.</li> <li>SLOBHD is seeking approval to use one-time MHSAs funds, available only in FY 24-25, to pay for the LPT to conduct this project.</li> </ul> <b>Outcomes:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Before June 30, 2024, the LPT assigned to the Homeless Services Project will conduct four trainings for County medical staff (e.g. LPTs, scribes, doctors) in working with unhoused populations.</li> <li>Before April 10, 2024, the LPT assigned to the Homeless Services Project will serve as a consultant to help draft the County’s competitive Behavioral Health Bridge Grant application.</li> <li>The LPT in the Homeless Services Project will train seven Community Action Team members in best practices for engaging unhoused clients in establishing and sustaining medication supports.</li> </ul>	

On Wednesday, January 31st, 2024: **Add 1.0 FTE LPT III for remainder of FY 24-25**
