IS THE POLLUTANT SEWAGE OR A HAZARDOUS MATERIAL?

Hazardous Material:

A material is considered hazardous if it is flammable, corrosive, or toxic.

Examples include: oil, gasoline, propane, anti-freeze, pesticide.

Sewage:

Examples include: spills, discharge from RVs, septic system failures, or line breaks.

Nuisance Material:

A nuisance material can harm the environment but doesn't threaten health or safety.

Examples include: soapy washwater, restaurant grease, muddy runoff.

Unknown Material:

A unknown material could be a threat to the public and the environment.

Examples include: foamy or odorous liquids or solids, unmarked drums or containers.
