<b>5)</b>	<b>Channel Maintenance</b>  County Staff Nathan Claud provided the following update: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The vegetation maintenance along the levy tops has been completed.</li><li>• The vegetation maintenance within the channel is scheduled to take place the first weeks of December.</li><li>• The hinges on the gate a Delta street have been replaced by a contractor.</li><li>• The flap gates have been inspected and maintenance performed.</li><li>• Trash is being monitored and removed.</li></ul>
<b>6)</b>	<b>AG Creek WMP Project Alt 3A and Mod. 3C Projects</b>  County Staff Nola Engelskirger provided the following project updates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Phase II construction will involve raising portions of the levee 1-2 feet along Arroyo Grande Creek and Los Berros Channel, removing vegetation and sediment and constructing log habitat structures in the stream channel, and installing slope reinforcement on south levee to mitigate potential erosion damage from overtopping events. This work will complete the final phase of the long-term project to improve</li></ul>

	<p>flood capacity of the Arroyo Grande Creek Channel.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Construction progress: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Sediment removal has been completed.</li> <li>○ Construction of log structures is completed.</li> <li>○ The levee in the Union Pacific right of way has been raised and is completed.</li> <li>○ Construction crews are working on raising the levy upstream of Highway 1.</li> <li>○ Construction crews are beginning preparations for the flood wall near the mobile home park.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
7)	<p><b>Meadow Creek Watershed Lagoon Restoration Plan</b></p> <p>County Staff Nola Engelskirger provided the following project updates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The RFP for consultant services to evaluate project alternatives has been released and consultant selection is underway. The winning proposal has not been announced.</li> </ul>
