
Stormwater Resource Plan (SWRP)

SB 985 requires a stormwater resource plan as a condition of receiving State bond grant funds approved after January 2014 for **storm water and/or dry-weather runoff projects**

- Prop 1 IRWM Implementation Grant
- Prop 1 Stormwater Grant Program (SWGPP) Round 2 Implementation



Stormwater Resource Plan (SWRP) regional efforts



Three SWRP efforts

- Countywide Watersheds
Proposition 1 IRWM 2016 Planning Grant
Lead Agency: **SLO County Flood Control District**
- Arroyo Grande Creek and Pismo Creek Watersheds
Proposition 1 Stormwater Grant Program
Lead Agency: **City of Arroyo Grande**
- San Luis Obispo Creek Watershed
Lead Agency: **City of San Luis Obispo**



Stormwater Resource Plan (SWRP) State Grant Funding

- **Coastal San Luis Resource Conservation District** is the project manager for both grant agreements:
 - San Luis Obispo County Flood Control and Water Conservation District
 - City of Arroyo Grande
- Project Management Team (PMT)
- Technical Consultant



Technical Advisory Committee (TAC)

“Establish a technical advisory committee (TAC) for the development of the SWRP that includes

- State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB),
- Central Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB), and
- Interested parties such as municipalities, water suppliers, local agencies, non-governmental organizations, public utilities, and regulatory agencies.”

- Contributor, review, plan development




TAC Areas

- **Salinas River** area – City of Paso Robles
- **Estrella River** area – Shandon San Juan Water District
- **Nipomo, Cuyama River, and Carrizo Plan** areas – County of San Luis Obispo
- **Arroyo Grande/Pismo Creek** – City of Arroyo Grande
- **SLO Creek** – City of San Luis Obispo
