AGENDA ITEM NUMBER: 3.1

ITEM: Vote to recommend five persons for appointment to vacant or expiring seats on the Homeless Services Oversight Council

ACTION REQUIRED: It is requested that the Homeless Services Oversight Council (HSOC) Executive Committee: approve the nominations of Brenda Mack for a second term for the Currently or Formerly Homeless Person seat she currently holds, William Crewe for a second term for the Veterans Service Representative seat he currently holds, Susan Lamont for a second term for the Victims' Services Representative seat she currently holds, Bettina Swigger for a second term for the Local Businesses/Business Organizations seat she currently holds, and Wendy Lewis for the Non-profit Service Providers seat previously held by Grace McIntosh; and recommend them to the San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors for appointment to the HSOC.

SUMMARY NARRATIVE:

There are 27 membership seats on the HSOC. Members are appointed to the HSOC by the County Board of Supervisors, with the exception of seven seats reserved for representatives from the seven incorporated cities in the County, which are appointed by the City Councils of each city, and one seat reserved for a representative from the County Board of Supervisors, which is appointed by the County Board of Supervisors. With the exception of the seats reserved for elected officials, members are appointed to three-year terms. To ensure continuity of the HSOC, term expirations are staggered among the seats, such that approximately 1/3 of the seats expire in a given year. Terms expire in January of the year in which the term ends.

There are currently four seats due to expire in January 2022. In addition, there are two other seats that are available for application due to resignations or expiring terms. At the September 2021 HSOC meeting, the terms that were expiring were reviewed and a request was made for applications from the public.

A total of seven applications were received. An ad hoc Nominating Committee met in October to consider the applications and recommended the following five candidates for seats on the HSOC:

Brenda Mack for the Currently or Formerly Homeless Person seat for a term that will expire January 2025. Ms. Mack has served as a volunteer for Transitions Mental Health Association's Life House clinic, currently serves as Housing Chair of SLO NAACP, and has worked as a Psychiatric Technician. She has also volunteered with community-based organizations to advocate on behalf of people experiencing homelessness and mental illness.

William Crewe for the Veterans Service Representative seat that will expire January 2025. Mr. Crewe is currently President for Central Coast Veterans Helping Veterans, Treasurer for SLO Veterans Services Collaborative, and serves on the Executive Committee for American Legion Post 66. He has played an active role in working to increase services for homeless veterans, including serving as a site Supervisor and Advisory Board member for Shower the People, participating as a Homeless Point in Time County volunteer, and serving on the HSOC Finance and Data Committee.

Susan Lamont for the Victims' Services Representative seat for a term that will expire January 2025. Ms. Lamont is the Interim Chief Program Officer for Lumina Alliance, which provides services and shelter to persons fleeing from intimate partner violence, and was formerly the Associate Director for RISE. In addition to her five years of experience at RISE and Lumina Alliance, Ms. Lamont has previously worked at the LINK in Atascadero and served as a patient advocate in Colorado.

Bettina Swigger for the Local Businesses/Business Organizations seat for a term that will expire January 2025. Ms. Swigger is the Chief Executive Officer of Downtown SLO, the nonprofit downtown business association which provides homeless outreach. Ms. Swigger has also served in the nonprofit sector for fifteen years.

Wendy Lewis for the Non-profit Service Providers seat vacated by Grace McIntosh for a term that will expire January 2024. Ms. Lewis has served as President and CEO of ECHO (El Camino Homeless Organization) for four years, as well as serving on the board for the Atascadero Chamber of Commerce and the Atascadero Babe Ruth Board.

BUDGET/FINANCIAL IMPACT

No current fiscal impact is anticipated.

STAFF COMMENTS:

It is recommended that the Homeless Services Oversight Council approve this item. Upon the HSOC's approval, staff will submit a recommendation for appointment to the Board of Supervisors.

I am the current CEO of the Food Bank Coalition of San Luis Obispo County (SLO Food Bank). I am also the past Fire Chief for the City of San Luis Obispo and a current resident of the City of San Luis Obispo who lives close to Mitchell Park.

The SLO Food Bank provides hunger relief to all in-need in our county. In addition to staffing over 60 distribution sites per month, we provide hunger relief resources to 83 other nonprofits, including organizations which provide assistant to those experiencing homelessness. Our No Cook Bag program is specifically designed to meet the unique needs of those experiencing homelessness.

I spent 30 years in the Fire Service in positions ranging from firefighter-paramedic up through fire chief. I have an intimate working knowledge of serving people from all walks of life, including those struggling with housing, substance abuse, mental health crisis, and extreme poverty. As CEO, I now lead our team to accomplish our mission to alleviate hunger and improve health in SLO County. A major component of our operations involves meeting the unique needs of our homeless clients.

I am driven by opportunities to learn, to analyze strategically, and to create meaningful change driven by data, opportunity, and collaboration. I've seen first-hand the tragic human realities faced by those who are most vulnerable, marginalized, and/or oftentimes invisible or dismissed in our society. I recognize the incredible complexity of this issue. I am a persistent change agent who believes all our time is too valuable to be spent meeting for meeting's sake. I am respectful of other's beliefs, and I am comfortable asking difficult questions and having difficult questions posed to me.
