Re: Draft Ordinance Regulating the Exportation of Groundwater

On October 16, 2014, the Paso Basin Advisory Committee (BAC) received a presentation and had a robust discussion regarding the subject draft ordinance. The BAC voted unanimously to include the Draft Ordinance Regulating the Exportation of Groundwater on its November agenda in order to make formal recommendations to your Board regarding the County's, Flood Control District's, and County and/or district contractors' exemption from the ordinance.

Action on the agenda item at the November 20, 2014 BAC meeting was limited to this exemption. Thus, the discussion at the November BAC meeting only addressed this exemption. Robust discussion still took place, and numerous other concerns were noted regarding the draft ordinance.

By unanimous vote, the BAC requested that the exemption for the County, Flood Control District, and County and/or district contractors be removed from the ordinance. The BAC clearly stated that this exemption is not appropriate.
