<p>Justification:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Need to reduce PEI expenses in FY 21-22; this cut will not impact any personnel. • Sustain PMAD Program for an additional one (1) year using prudent reserve funds. • Sustaining PMAD Program for one (1) year will enable the Public Health Department to provide PMAD/Post-Partum Training sessions to local therapists, local hotline staff, hospital staff, and community-based organization front-line staff and outreach materials while future funding can be procured. <p>Outcomes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Four (4) PMAD/Post-Partum Trainings per year • 25 clinical professionals receive a Maternal Mental Health Certificate for PPSI per year • 45 therapists, hotline staff, hospital staff, and CBO front-line staff receive PMAD training • 30% of program partners will report a formalized PMAD referral process and linkage to community resources • 30% of program partners will report an increase in knowledge of PMAD • 30% of program partners will report use of validated PMAD screening tools
