Minutes

1. Frank Warren welcomed the stakeholder group at 3:00 p.m. All participants introduced themselves and Frank presented goals for meeting. Frank also reviewed the Stakeholder process, format and rules for the meeting (e.g. consensus voting, no rules of order, etc.)
 - a. Frank introduced Nestor Veloz-Passalacqua, SLOBHD. Frank discussed Nestor's roll at the County starting May 8 as the permanent ASO II, who will be the PEI and Innovation Coordinator.
2. Frank presented the PEI program updates including the 5-component work plan.

 - a. Presentation given by Lauren Rocha, SLOBHD. Lauren discussed the College based Wellness Program, including connecting County and community wellness services and activities with the college campuses. Lauren heads the Cal Poly Friday Night Live (FNL) program and is on campus on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
 - b. James Statler, CCC, gave an update on the Community Counseling Center. CCC has expanded its services with those 12-24 years of age.
3. Raven Lopez, SLOBHD, presented the fiscal update and discussed the " No Place Like Home" program, handouts were given to members. Raven also announced she will be assuming the Accounting position for Drug and Alcohol Services.
4. Frank discussed Successful Launch program which serves the at-risk San Luis Obispo County youth between the ages of 16-25, handouts were given to members. Frank proposed making a decision about keeping or redesigning the program at the June 15 meeting.
