

# Alternative Review Program (ARP)

The RCD has partnered with the County of San Luis Obispo to provide a low cost alternative to obtaining a County Grading Permit.

ARP applies to agricultural grading projects as defined by the County Grading Ordinance Section 22.52 and includes:

- A Site/Project Evaluation
- Permit Assistance with regulatory agencies
- Erosion Control Recommendations

#### **EXAMPLES OF ELIGIBLE PROJECTS:**

- GRADING ON VEGETATION REMOVAL
- NEW AGRICULTURAL ROADS
- PONDS, DAMS AND RESERVOIRS
