Focus on Industry Employment

Civilian Employment

Estimates are based on place of residence

Includes individuals who worked at least 1 hour for a wage or salary during the week including the 12th of the month

Includes self-employed, those worked at least 15 unpaid hours in a family business or on a family farm

Individuals with multiple jobs are counted only once

Industry Employment

Estimates are based on place of work

Jobs are counted regardless of the hours worked during the week including the 12th of the month

Excludes self-employed, unpaid family workers, and private household employees

Each job is counted once






Agriculture: Monthly Changes

Other Seasonal Industries

- Stronger Seasonal Patterns
 - Retail trade (highest around October and November)
 - Food services and drinking place (highest in summer)
 - Education (lowest in summer)
- Weaker Seasonal Patterns
 - Construction (lower in winter)
 - Manufacturing (lower towards winter)
 - Professional and business services (higher in summer)
 - Transportation (higher in spring and summer)
