1	Increase due to COLA increase in salaries.
2	Decrease due to a reduction of minutes in the time study.
3	Remain the same due to changes in the time study and an organizational change in positions associated with the

5	Increase due to COLA increase in salaries and an organizational change in positions associated with the process.
6	Remain the same due to a reduction of minutes in the time study.
7	Increase due to a COLA increase in salaries and changes in the time study to more accurately capture the minutes spent in the performance of tasks.
8	Cost incurred in processing a new license and a renewal license is averaged; the same fee amount is proposed for both. The fee will remain the same due to a decrease in the number of new business licenses issued and an increase in the number of issued renewal licenses.
9	Survey of comparable counties determined that fee was reasonable.
10	Remain the same due to an organizational change in positions associated with the process.
11	Decrease due to an organizational change in positions associated with the process.
12	Statutory fee; will remain unchanged.
13	New fee.
14	This is a State mandated fee, paid to the State if sale proceeds exceed \$1.50; no revenue to County.
15	State receives \$5.00 of fee and the County General Fund receives \$10 as non-departmental revenue.
16	\$25.00 + 1/4 of 1% of anything over \$10,000. The fee is renewed annually, and prorated in the last year of administration.
17	The fee is: 4% of the first \$100,000; 3% of the next \$100,000; 2% of the next \$800,000, etc. There is a \$1,000 minimum compensation for estates handled by the Public Administrator. (Most PA estates do not exceed \$30,000 and therefore fall in this category.)
