13	Crime Lab Fee. These are billed to outside agencies and other County Departments.
14	Crime Lab Fee. In house substance testing reimbursable rate is based on Health and Safety Code 11372.5 Persons convicted of a violations shall pay a criminal laboratory analysis fee in the amount of fifty dollars (\$50). This fee is maintained by the County Treasurer/Auditor's Office. This money is to fund costs incurred by lab oratories providing chemical analyses of the controlled substgance. Revenue from this fund is transferred monthly to the Sheriff's Department Crime Lab. In the past these had ben completed by an outside vendor. We also bill one outside agency, California Men's Colony (CMC) approx. 200 units annually. The propped rate of \$58 would apply to this outside agency and other future billable outside agencies.
