This money is to fund costs incurred by laboratories providing chemical analyses of the controlled substance. Revenue from this fund is transferred monthly to the Sheriff's Department Crime Lab. In the past these had been completed by an outside vendor. We also bill outside agencies approx. 16 units annually. The proposed rate of \$ 65 would apply to these billable outside agencies.
