1	The Planning Department collects this fee for County Fire.			
2	Includes written fire safety plan, one site visit and final inspection, up to 4.5 hours included in base fee.			
3	Includes written fire safety plan, up to three site visits, and final inspection, up to 6.75 hours included in base fee.			
4	Includes plan review, one site visit/final inspection, up to 2.75 hours included in base fee.			
5	Includes written fire safety plan, up to three site visits, and final inspection, up to 8 hours included in base fee.			
6	Services in excess of those listed above will be billed at \$88/hour.			
7	For projects up to 4,999 sq ft, base fee only. For projects 5,000 sq ft or larger, base fee plus \$.06 per sq ft over 4,999 sq ft. Additional per hour charges may also apply - see footnote 6.			
8	Fire Safety Plans not required for buildings/additions under 500 sq ft, unless, with addition, building exceeds 5,000 sq ft.			
9	Projects exceeding 10 parcels will be assessed an additional .5 hours (\$44.00) per parcel above 10 parcels.			
10	The Fire Chief is authorized to waive fees for applicants who are seeking to reconstruct legally constructed homes and other structures, including associated grading, that were destroyed as a result of a natural or manmade disaster, where the Board of Supervisors adopts a resolution declaring such a disaster.
