1	Cost increase due to an increase in salaries and an increase in the ICRP Rates.
2	Cost increase due to an increase in salaries, an increase in the ICRP Rates, plus changes in the time study to more accurately capture the performance of tasks.
3	Although there was an increase in salaries and an increase in the ICRP Rates, the fee remained the same due to a reduction of minutes in the time study.
