Recommendation

It is recommended that your Board approve and instruct the Chairperson to sign the "Resolution Proclaiming the Termination of Local Emergency Related to the Early January 2006 Storms."

Discussion

On January 5, 2006 your Board ratified the Proclamation of Local Emergency made on January 4, 2006 by David Edge, County Administrative Officer and Emergency Services Director, due to effects from and as a result of severe winter storms. The proclamation was retroactive to Monday January 2, 2006 at 12:01 A.M.

County Code section 2.80.070(2) states that the Board of Supervisors shall review, at least every fourteen days until such local emergency is terminated, the need for continuing the local emergency and shall proclaim the termination of such local emergency at the earliest possible date that conditions warrant.

Due to the ongoing response and recovery efforts to date, the reasons for making the Proclamation of Local Emergency, which included flooding, landslides, fallen trees, power outages, and related damages including severe sewage system disruption resulting in public health issues, no longer are an immediate threat to the public health and safety. As a result, County OES is recommending the Board approve and instruct the Chairperson to sign the related "Resolution Proclaiming the Termination of Local Emergency Related to the Early January 2006 Storms." Approving this request and signing the related resolution will result in the Proclamation of Local Emergency terminating at 11:59 P.M. on January 24, 2006.

Other Agency Involvement

County Counsel has reviewed Resolution Proclaiming the Termination of Local Emergency Related to the Early January 2006 Storms.

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Financial Considerations

There are no costs related to this request.

Results

Allowing the termination of the Proclamation of Local Emergency will ensure the County is compliance with County Code Title 2, Chapter 2.80.070. While there are no direct results to terminating the Proclamation, other than meeting the above requirement, the Proclamation itself did result in allowing County resources to be used as effectively as possible during the time it was in effect, thus helping to ensure prompt and coordinated initial response and recovery efforts.

**RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING THE TERMINATION OF LOCAL
EMERGENCY RELATED TO THE EARLY JANUARY 2006 STORMS**

The following resolution is offered and read:

WHEREAS, a Proclamation of Local Emergency for the entire County was made by the Director of Emergency Services on January 4, 2006, due to the effects of heavy storms; and

WHEREAS, The Proclamation of Local Emergency took effect at 12:01 a.m., January 2, 2006, to remain in effect for a period of 14 days unless extended or terminated; and

WHEREAS, As required by County Code section 2.80.070(1), the Board of Supervisors ratified the Proclamation of Local Emergency on January 5, 2006; and

WHEREAS, County Code section 2.80.070(2) requires that the Board of Supervisors shall review, at least every fourteen days until such local emergency is terminated, the need for continuing the local emergency and shall proclaim the termination of such local emergency at the earliest possible date that conditions warrant; and

WHEREAS, on January 10, 2006, the County Board of Supervisors reviewed the need to extend and continue the Proclamation of Local Emergency; and

WHEREAS, on January 10, 2006, the County Board of Supervisors concluded that conditions exist warranting extending and continuing the Proclamation of Local Emergency; and

WHEREAS, the reasons for making the Proclamation of Local Emergency, which included flooding, landslides, fallen trees, power outages, and related damages including severe sewage system disruption resulting in public health issues, no longer are

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an immediate threat to the public health and safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED, by the San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors that the Proclamation of Local Emergency for San Luis Obispo County related to the early January 2006 heavy storms is to be terminated at 11:59 p.m. on January 24, 2006.
