**SUBJECT:** Submittal of a Resolution Amending the Traffic Regulation Code Establishing Disabled Person's Parking and Angled Parking Spaces on Cammatti Street, Shandon; Murphy Avenue, Santa Margarita; Establish Disabled Parking on Seventeenth Street and Nineteenth Street in Oceano

## Recommendation

It is recommended that your Board approve the attached resolution amending the Traffic Regulation Code Establishing Disabled Person's Parking and Angled Parking.

## Discussion

The Department of Public Works received a request from County General Services for Disabled Parking as part of their work on the Community Halls located at Camatti Street, Shandon and Murphy Avenue, Santa Margarita to bring them into compliance with the American's With Disabilities Act (ADA). Angled Parking spaces will accommodate the disabled spaces.

Additionally, at the request of Oceano School Principal to better utilize parking around the school, he has asked for more disabled parking on Nineteenth Street. This will provide better classroom access. Decreasing disabled parking on Seventeenth will better serve the library and school facility, while still providing disabled parking.

## Other Agency Involvement/Impact

Oceano Elementary School, and County of San Luis Obispo General Services Department has been consulted on proposed action, California Highway Patrol will enforce.

## Financial Considerations

Signage at the Shandon and Santa Margarita location has already been installed by General Services. The Oceano site will cost \$400 to remove and reestablish disabled parking on Seventeenth and Nineteenth Streets. This is within the expected activity of the Roads budget.

Approval of the recommended action will facilitate parking for the disabled in the locations noted. Ultimately, this action will provide for a safer and better governed community.





Amendments to the Traffic Regulation Code  
County of San Luis Obispo

Establishment of Disabled Parking and Angled Parking

I. The following new sections are added to Chapter 15.402 of the San Luis Obispo Code

15.402800 Camatti Street, Shandon After signs are erected giving notice thereof, the following location is designated as a parking area for the exclusive use of disabled persons and disabled veterans displaying special license plates or distinguishing placards issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles.

Along the southerly side of Camatti Street (County Road No. 5282) from a point fifty-eight feet westerly of the centerline of Second Street (County Road No. 5278) to a point eighty-four feet westerly of said centerline.

15.402.700 Murphy Avenue, Santa Margarita After signs are erected giving notice thereof, the following location is designated as a parking area for the exclusive use of disabled persons and disabled veterans displaying special license plates or distinguishing placards issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles.

Along the southwesterly side of Murphy Avenue (County Road No. 3111) from a point fifty feet southeasterly of the centerline of I Street (County Road No. 3115) to a point seventy-six feet southeasterly of said centerline.

15.402.502 Nineteenth Street, Oceano After signs are erected giving notice thereof, the following location is designated as a parking area for the exclusive use of disabled persons and disabled veterans displaying special license plates or distinguishing placards issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles.

Along the westerly side of Nineteenth Street (County Road No. 1115) from a point twenty-five feet northerly of the centerline of Warner Street (County Road No. 1126) to a point seventh-five feet northerly of said centerline.

II. The following section is amended to Chapter 15.402 of the San Luis Obispo Code.

15.402.500 Seventeenth Street at Oceano Elementary School The following location is designated as a parking area for the exclusive use of disabled persons and disabled veterans displaying distinguishing license plates or placards along the easterly side of Seventeenth Street (County Road No. 1113) from a point forty feet south of the intersection of the prolongation of the centerline of Warner Street (County Road No. 1126) with said easterly side to a point ninety feet southerly of the intersection of the prolongation of the centerline of said Warner Street.

III. The following section is amended to Chapter 15.72 of the San Luis Obispo Code.

15.72.200 Establishment in Town of Santa Margarita Angled parking is created and established along the southwesterly side of Murphy Avenue (County Road No. 3111) from a point forth feet southeasterly of the centerline of I Street (County Road No. 3115) to a point one hundred fifth feet southeasterly of said centerline.

15.72.300 Establishment in Town of Shandon Angled parking is created and established along the southerly side of Cammatti Street (County Road No. 5282) from a point thirty-five feet westerly of the centerline of Second Street (County Road No. 5278) to a point one hundred forty feet westerly of said centerline.
