(4) SUBJECT Submittal of a Resolution Amending the Traffic Regulation Code for the Establishment of Speed Limits on Oak Park Road, North of the City of Arroyo Grande; Woodland Hills Road and Pomeroy Road, South of the City of Arroyo Grande, Pecho Valley Road and Los Osos Valley Road in Los Osos					
(5) SUMMARY OF REQUEST The Department of Public Works received complaints about speed issues on Oak Park Road, Woodland Hills, and Pomeroy Road. This requested action will establish a speed limit on Woodland Hills and Oak Park Road of forty-five miles per hour. The section of Pomeroy Road from Camino Perrillo to a point one mile southeasterly shall be fifty miles per hour. Establishing speed limits will enhance enforcement opportunities on these streets. Pecho Valley Road and Los Osos Valley Road speed limit is being raised after a speed survey was conducted. The enforceable speed limit would now be 40 miles per hour.					
(6) RECOMMENDED ACTION It is our recommendation that your Board approve the attached Resolution amending the Traffic Regulation Code Establishing Speed Limits on Oak Park Road, Woodland Hills Road and Pomeroy Road in rural Arroyo Grande, Los Osos Valley Road and Pecho Valley Road in Los Osos.

SUBJECT: Submittal of a Resolution Amending the Traffic Regulation Code for the Establishment of Speed Limits on Oak Park Road, North of the City of Arroyo Grande; Woodland Hills Road and Pomeroy Road, South of the City of Arroyo Grande, Los Osos Valley Road and Pecho Valley Road in Los Osos

Recommendation

It is our recommendation that your Board approve the attached Resolution amending the Traffic Regulation Code Establishing Speed Limits on Oak Park Road, Woodland Hills Road and Pomeroy Road in rural Arroyo Grande, Los Osos Valley Road and Pecho Valley Road in Los Osos.

Discussion

Woodland Hills Road is a narrow minor road connecting State Route 1 and El Campo Road. At the request from residents living on the streets mentioned, a speed survey was completed. The road does not qualify for a 25 mile per hour residential district. The enforceable speed limit would be 45 miles per hour.

The section of Pomeroy Road from Camino Perrillo to a point one mile southeasterly is a narrow two lane collector street. At the request of the residents, a speed zone survey was conducted for this section. The enforceable speed limit would be 50 miles per hour.

Oak Park Road is currently posted for 40 miles per hour from City of Arroyo Grande speed zone survey. Motorists had recently challenged a ticket citation for 40 miles per hour. A new speed zone survey was conducted which established a 45 mile per hour enforceable limit. By passing this resolution it will bring this section of the road within requirements of the California Vehicle Code Section 22358.

Los Osos Valley Road/Pecho Valley road is currently posted for 35 miles per hour from the State Park entrance on the west end to Palisades Avenue on the east end. A new speed zone survey

was conducted which established a 40 miles per hour enforceable limit. By passing this resolution, it will bring this section of the road within requirements of the California Vehicle Code Section 22358.

Other Agency Involvement/Impact

The California Highway Patrol will provide enforcement. The Nipomo Advisory Council and Los Osos Community Advisory Council have been notified of these proposed changes.

Financial Considerations

Posting of the proposed speed limits is estimated to cost approximately \$400 for each road. This is within the Roads budgeted amount for this activity.

Results

Approval of the recommended action will allow law enforcement officials to establish specific maximum speed limits on these County roads, and therefore, enforce proper vehicle speeds along residential streets. This will enhance community livability and safety, which is a community wide objective of our staff and your Board



OAK PARK RD.**


NOYES RD. TO P.B./A.G. CITY LIMITS

HWY 1 TO EL CAMPO RD.





Exhibit A
Amendments to the Traffic Regulation Code
County of San Luis Obispo

Establishment of Speed Limits

- I. That Chapter 15.12, 15.10 and 15.14 of Title 15 of the San Luis Obispo Traffic Regulation Code is hereby amended by adding the following sections.

15.12.172 Oak Park Road The speed limit shall be forty-five miles per hour on Oak Park Road (County Road No. 2002) between its intersection with Noyes Road (County Road No. 2003) to the Arroyo Grande, Pismo Beach city limits.

15.12.131 Woodland Hills Road The speed limit shall be forty-five miles per hour on Woodland Hills Road (County Road No. 1249) from the intersection with California State Highway Route One to the intersection of El Campo Road (County Road No. 1393).

15.14.060 Pomeroy Road The speed limit shall be fifty miles per hour on Pomeroy Road (County Road No. 1034) from the intersection with Camino Perrillo (County Road No. 1388) to a point one mile southeasterly from said road.

15.10.300 Los Osos Valley and Pecho Valley Roads The speed limit shall be forty miles per hour on Los Osos Valley Road and Pecho Valley Road (County Road No. 2088) from Palisades Avenue (County road No. 3057) thence westerly and southerly to the boundary of Montano de Oro State Park.

- II. That Chapter 15.08 of Title 15 of the San Luis Obispo Traffic Regulation Code is hereby amended by deleting the following section.

15.08.320 Los Osos Valley and Pecho Valley Roads The speed limit shall be thirty-five miles per hour on Los Osos Valley road and Pecho Valley Road (County Road No. 2088) from Palisades Avenue (County Road No. 3057) thence, westerly and southerly to the boundary of Montana de Oro State Park. (Ord. 2115 § 2, 1983: Ord. 1727 § 1, 1977)
