SUBJECT: PUBLIC HEARING TO AMEND THE URBAN COUNTY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO PROGRAM YEAR 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 AND 2005 ACTION PLANS

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that your Board adopt the attached resolution to amend the 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, and 2005 Action Plans as requested by the City of Grover Beach for submittal to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

DISCUSSION

This item was originally scheduled on the January 24, 2006 Board agenda and continued to allow the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) additional time to make an eligibility determination with the federal regulations for the proposed Mentone Storm Drain Project in the City of Grover Beach.

City of Grover Beach

The City of Grover Beach is requesting that the County of San Luis Obispo amend the Program Year 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, and 2005 Annual Action Plans to reallocate a total of \$412,112.67 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. The funds are for the Mentone Avenue Storm Drain Project and to construct and reconstruct infrastructure improvements including handicap ramps, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, public utilities, parks, and streets in predominately low and moderate-income areas. On January 17, 2006 the Grover Beach City Council approved the reallocation of funds as follows:

1. Amend the 2001 Annual Action Plan to reallocate \$1,000 from Code Enforcement in the Redevelopment Agency area to the Mentone Storm Drain Project and for infrastructure improvements as described above. Total CDBG funds proposed for

reallocation from the 2001 Action Plan totals \$1,000.

2. Amend the 2002 Annual Action Plan to reallocate \$3,082.60 from the EOC Minor Home Repair Program; \$649 from the UCP Supportive Child Care Program; \$2,010 from the Cuesta College Small Business Development Center; \$16,515.46 from the City of Grover Beach CDBG Administration; and \$13,992.47 from Code Enforcement in the Redevelopment Area, to the Mentone Storm Drain Project and for infrastructure improvements as described above. Total CDBG funds proposed for reallocation from the 2002 Action Plan totals \$36,249.53.
3. Amend the 2003 Annual Action Plan to reallocate \$25,000 from the EOC Home Repair Program; \$400.36 from Park and Recreation Youth Scholarships(City of Grover Beach); \$31,300.75 from sidewalk handicap ramps; \$34,843 from American with Disabilities Act (ADA) City Hall Building improvements; \$17,101 from American with Disabilities (ADA) City Hall Building Improvements; \$25,000 from 16th Street Park Improvements; \$3,000 from the Cuesta College Small Business Development Center; \$9,400 from the City of Grover Beach CDBG administration; and \$10,008 from code enforcement in the Redevelopment Area, to the Mentone Storm Drain Project and for infrastructure improvements as described above. Total CDBG funds proposed for reallocation from the 2003 Action Plan totals \$156,053.11.
4. Amend the 2004 Annual Action Plan to reallocated \$220 from the Literacy Council; \$9,240 from the City of Grover Beach Youth Scholarships; \$28.54 from the Exploration Station Youth Scholarships;\$2,042 from the Y-Teen X-Treme Program by SLO Co. YMCA; \$29,223.49 from Code Enforcement in the Redevelopment Area; \$24,000 from Handicap Sidewalk Ramps; \$40,000 in program income for American with Disabilities (ADA) City Hall Building Improvements; \$2,819 from Handicap Picnic Tables/BBQ's and Water Fountains; \$3,000 from the Cuesta College Small Business Development Center; and \$25,000 from the CDBG Administration to the Mentone Storm Drain Project and for infrastructure improvements as described above. Total CDBG funds proposed for reallocation from the 2004 Action Plan totals \$135,573.03.
5. Amend the 2005 Annual Action Plan to reallocate \$57,037 from Code Enforcement in the Redevelopment Area; \$5,000 from the Grover Beach Housing General Plan Element implementation; \$4,500 from Cuesta College Small Business Development Center; and \$16,700 from the CDBG Administration, to the Mentone Storm Drain Project and for infrastructure improvements as described above. Total CDBG funds proposed for reallocation from the 2005 Action Plan totals \$83,237.

The City of Grover Beach has determined that the proposed activities to be eliminated from the Action Plans have not shown any progress in spending down their funds and have indicated they will not be using them anytime in the near future.

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE AMENDMENT OF THE URBAN COUNTY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO PROGRAM YEAR 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, and 2005 ACTION PLANS

The following resolution is hereby offered and read:

WHEREAS, the County of San Luis Obispo encourages citizen participation in the amendment of the Consolidated Plan (hereinafter referred to as "the Plan") which outlines the community needs for housing and community development; and

WHEREAS, the City of Grover Beach determined that there was a need to reallocate Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from several activities to the proposed Mentone Avenue Storm Drain project and to construct and reconstruct infrastructure improvements including handicap ramps, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, public utilities, parks and streets in predominately low and moderate-income areas, the City Council met on January 17, 2006 and approved the reallocation of \$412,113 from the 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, and 2005 Action Plans; and

WHEREAS, the City of Grover Beach made the following reallocations from the 2001 Action Year as follows: reallocate \$1,000 from Code Enforcement in the Redevelopment Agency area to the Mentone Storm Drain Project and for infrastructure improvements as described above.
