**SUBJECT: Hearing to Consider a Resolution Amending the Traffic Regulation Code for the Enforcement of the California Vehicle Code on Private Roads within Tract 6D and Tract 17, East of Paso Robles**

## Recommendation

It is recommended that your Board adopt the resolution amending the Traffic Regulation Code for the Enforcement of the California Vehicle Code on Private Roads within Tract 6D and Tract 17, East of Paso Robles.

## Discussion

Staff has received requests from residents along Buckhorn Ridge Place, east of Hog Canyon Road, and on Iverson Place, west of Geneseo Road, regarding vehicle size, speeds and collisions.

Iverson Place is a gravel road accessing lots within Tract 17. Residents have submitted a petition for enforcement of the vehicle code. Their concern involves operation of high speed low profile motorized vehicles on this street creating unsafe conditions for the operators and travelers on Iverson place. Adoption of the proposed resolution will prohibit the operation of vehicles on Iverson Place that do not meet the Vehicle Code requirements.

Once adopted, the residents of these streets will place signs indicating "Private Road – California Vehicle Code Enforced" along with other signs indicating weight restrictions or vehicle requirements. After posting these signs, residents can request California Highway Patrol to monitor, enforce and respond to traffic collisions and complaints on Buckhorn Ridge Place and Iverson Place. Adoption of the commercial vehicle prohibitory does not require a public hearing.

**Other Agency Involvement/Impact**

The CHP enforces the Vehicle Code on County Roads, and supports these revisions in order to more effectively enforce the code sections on these streets.

**Financial Considerations**

Placement of signs and markings is estimated to cost approximately \$200 and will be paid for by the affected residents.

**Results**

Adoption of this ordinance will allow the CHP to enforce traffic regulations on Buckhorn Ridge Place and Iverson Place, and will generally enhance neighborhood safety and livability.







To the Board of Supervisors:

We, the undersigned property owners / residents, are requesting a review of the situation, which currently exists on the above-mentioned road. We are requesting to adopt an ordinance, which would allow owners / residence to enforce the California Vehicle Code on this above privately owned road. We understand that we, the owners / residents, would be responsible for contacting the Templeton CHP to enforce any traffic code violation if this petition is accepted. This road is maintained at the expense of each property owner and there are currently approximately 40 land/home owners. This road is being used in an unsafe manner by off road vehicles (Dirt bikes, quads, mini bikes, etc.) driven by unlicensed riders in this area. The issues that are of concern are racing, speeding, destruction / deterioration of the road, noise and dust. Because many public vehicles access this road, using it as a recreational area is both unsafe and unwise, clearly not it's intended purpose. Simply contacting the people / parents responsible for the misuse of the road meets with no result.

We respectfully request that the county look into this matter and approve our request.



**Amendments to the Traffic Regulation Code  
County of San Luis Obispo**

**Establishment of State of California Vehicle Code  
Enforcement on Private Roads**

- I. The following new sections are added to Chapter 15.45 of the San Luis Obispo County Traffic Regulation Code:

15.45.101 Application of State of California Vehicle Code to Tract 6D. After signs are erected giving notice thereof, the following locations are designated as roadways subject to the provisions of the State of California Vehicle Code.

Roads in Tract 6D are generally held open for use by the public and connect highways so that the public cannot determine that these roads are not highways. This Chapter shall apply to those privately owned and maintained roads that are contained within the exterior boundary of Tract 6D as shown in Book 5 Page 29 of maps in the County Recorder's Office, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California.

15.45.102 Application of State of California Vehicle Code to Tract 17. After signs are erected giving notice thereof, the following locations are designated as roadways subject to the provisions of the State of California Vehicle Code.

Roads in Tract 17 are generally held open for use by the public and connect highways so that the public cannot determine that these roads are not highways. This Chapter shall apply to those privately owned and maintained roads that are contained within the exterior boundary of Tract 17 as shown in Book 5 Page 33 of maps in the County Recorder's Office, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California.
