WHEREAS, Kim Murry has served as an Associate, Senior and Supervising Planner and currently as the Division Manager for the Public Information and Technology Division with the Department of Planning and Building from 1985 to the present; and

WHEREAS, Kim Murry early in her career worked in the Current Planning Division of the Department as staff for the Planning Commission, Subdivision Review Board and Board of Supervisors, and

WHEREAS, Kim Murry worked at and became the Supervising Planner for the Planning Permit Center and supervised this section from 1991 to 2002 working on continuous improvements in our services, and

WHEREAS, Kim Murry was the Project Manager for the Tidemark Tracking system that brought the department's permit tracking system into the 21st century and has continued to expand services to include 24/7 internet access to check on the status of permits and zoning of property as well as the soon to be released e-permits where you will be able to apply and pay for permits and schedule inspection requests on line without having to come into the office, and

WHEREAS, Kim Murry became the Division Manager for the Public Information and Technology division in 2003 and has overseen the Department technical staff in the development of such improved technology as ability to obtain faxes of plan check corrections, property zoning information, and inspections results via an automated phone system; transition to gigabyte network to enable all staff access to GIS and other network speed-reliant programs; increased information on the Department's web page; transitioned the Department to MS Word; and has also overseen the Planning Permit Center staff; Legal Lot/Certificate of Compliance sections and Department Phone Center, and

WHEREAS, Kim Murry was voted Department Employee of the year for the year 2000; and

WHEREAS, Kim Murry's cool, calm and collected approach brings people together to solve real problems and her ability to bring technology to the non-technical has brought the department into the 21st century, and

WHEREAS, Kim Murry has taken the Growth Management System forward in the last three years to address unresolved issues in Cambria and Nipomo and set the stage for the Growth Management System to be integrated with the Board-adopted Smart Growth Principles, and

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors wishes to recognize Kim Murry's contributions to the Board of Supervisors, County Planning Commission, County staff, and the people of San Luis Obispo County and to County government as she leaves for the new opportunity as Deputy Director for the City of San Luis Obispo (and where we all know where to find her when we need her help).


