Ballots were sent to all military and overseas voters on May 18 for the June 22 special primary election to fill the vacancy in Senate District 15. If you have not received your ballot, you may download the ballot and the oath of voter and fax both of those to our office by the close of the polls on June 22nd. You must be aware, however, if you return your voted ballot via fax transmission, your vote is no longer secret.

Follow the instructions below:

FAX RETURN OF AVOTED BALLOT

Print the ballot and the "OATH OF VOTER" form. Mark the ballot with your choice. Complete and sign the "OATH OF VOTER" form. Fax both the oath of voter form and the ballot back to the fax number below before the close of polls (8:00 p.m Pacific Standard Time) on June 22nd. The ballot cannot be counted unless accompanied in the same transmission by this oath and your signature.

Nevertheless, I understand that, as with any absent voter, my signature, whether on this oath of voter form or my identification envelope, will be permanently separated from my voted ballot to maintain its secrecy at the outset of the tabulation process and thereafter.

I swear or affirm under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that I am:

1. A member of the Uniformed Services or merchant marine on active duty; or an eligible spouse or dependent of such a member; or, a U.S. citizen temporarily residing outside the U.S.; or, Other U.S. citizen residing outside the U.S.; and
2. I am a U.S. citizen, at least 18 years of age (or will be by the date of the election), and I am eligible to vote in the requested jurisdiction; and
3. I have not been convicted of a felony, or other disqualifying offense, or been adjudicated mentally incompetent, or if so, my voting rights have been reinstated; and
4. I am not registered, requesting a ballot, or voting in any other jurisdiction in the U.S., except the jurisdiction cited in this voting form. In voting, I have marked my ballot in private and have not allowed any person to observe the marking of the ballot, except for those authorized to assist voters under State or Federal law. I have not been influenced. My signature and date below indicate when I completed this document. The information on this form is true, accurate, and complete to the best of my knowledge. I understand that a material misstatement of fact in completion of this document may constitute grounds for a conviction of perjury.
