

ORDINANCE NO. 3245

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 2.12.010 and
2.12.020 OF THE COUNTY CODE**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 2.12.010 **Qualifications** of the County Code shall be amended as follows:

2.12.010 - Qualifications.

The provisions of Government Code Title 3, Chapter 4, Article 4 (commencing with Government Code Section 26945); and Chapter 5, Article 1 (commencing with Government Code Section 27000) and any amendments made subsequent thereto are hereby adopted and made applicable to the position of auditor-controller-treasurer-tax collector-public administrator. To be eligible for election or appointment to the office of auditor-controller-treasurer-tax collector-public administrator, a person must possess the qualifications established by state law, including but not limited to Government Code Section 26945 and Government Code Section 27000.7 for both county auditor and county treasurer-tax collector. Evidence of such qualifications shall be presented to the registrar of voters with a candidate's nomination papers.

SECTION 2: Section 2.12.020 **Continuing education** of the County Code shall be amended as follows:

2.12.020 - Continuing education.

The provisions of Government Code Title 3, Chapter 4, Article 4 , concerning continuing education requirements for the county auditor of the county of San Luis Obispo, as described in Government Code Section 26945.1, and any amendments made subsequent thereto, and the provisions of Chapter 5, Article 1 concerning the continuing education requirements for the county treasurer-tax collector of the county of San Luis Obispo, as described in Government Code Section 27000.8 and any amendments made subsequent thereto are adopted and shall become effective on the effective date of the ordinance codified in this chapter.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its passage; and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after passage of this ordinance, it shall be published once with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the ordinance in The Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California.
