Mr. Hamm mentioned that he is hoping there will be some grant opportunities associated with the federal directive to implement. In addition, Mr. Hamm requested that any new information found or received, be shared. This is a large topic that will take a community effort to implement.

The discussion regarding Children's Mental Health segued into the recent conclusion of a long-term study of babies born addicted to crack cocaine. The surprising conclusion is that poverty, rather than drug exposure is the bigger danger to children. A request was made by several members that anyone with access to Dr. Hallam Hurt's study, please forward it to the committee.
