Dear Board:

We received notification via letter sent October 15, 2015 that the above-named inmate is being considered for early parole release after serving 50% of his sentence. We object because he is unsuitable, and would present a substantial danger to public safety if released now.

Inmate Delgado has an EPRD of August 25, 2018 according to his CDCR records. No early release should be considered, as he was sentenced just two years ago, October 2013, to 5 years for a violation of 4573.6.

His strike is for a very violent offense: P.C. section 246.3, discharging a firearm in a grossly negligent manner. He has five prior prison terms. He has been active in a gang, the "Oceano 13" a Sureno subset, with a moniker of "PeeWee". He has a conviction here for domestic violence, case #F382175, in 2006. "Non-violent" does not apply to Delgado.

This inmate poses a serious risk to public safety and should not be given the benefits of early release on parole.
