**FOUR DEFENDANTS CHARGED WITH  
HUMAN TRAFFICKING OF  
15 YEAR OLD FEMALE VICTIM**

SAN LUIS OBISPO, CA – District Attorney Dan Dow announced today the filing of human trafficking related charges against three adults and one juvenile.

The four have been charged with California's relatively new human trafficking statute, felony Penal Code section 236.1(c)(2). The defendants are Brianna Day Morales (dob 9/8/94), Fabio Silveira (dob 12/2/94), both of Chico, California, Elijah Wolfson (dob 6/10/96) and 16 year old Nikko Anaya (dob 3/30/99) of Manteca, California. Nikko Anaya is also charged with felony dissuading a witness by force or threat in violation of Penal Code section 136.1(c)(1). The victim, a 15 year old female, is alleged to have been trafficked by the four defendants for commercial sex acts between 7/23/15 and 7/28/15 in Santa Cruz, Pismo Beach, and San Luis Obispo.

Although Nikko Anaya is a juvenile, his is being charged as an adult pursuant to the District Attorney's discretion to file certain felonies directly in adult court pursuant to Proposition 21, approved by the voters in March of 2000.

Brianna Morales has posted bail and is to appear for arraignment on 8/12/15. The other defendants will be arraigned 7/31/15.

The case was investigated by the San Luis Obispo Police Department.
