PRISON REFORM	<u>John Gannon</u> Presentation on Re-entry. Better systemic approaches in dealing with criminals. 70% recidivism has politicians looking at alternative approaches. (Year to release re-entry programs) Marie Chaney with the Parole Division to be asked to do a DAAB presentation in February.	
GAMBLING ADDICTION	<u>Jason Reed</u> shared that the Office of Problem Gambling falls under state ADP. <u>John Lovern</u> showed a video on “Compulsive Gambling & Recovery”. Monies expected to come to SLO county at some point. Gambling addiction is viewed as a co-occurring disorder and DAS screening was suggested to add/include gambling.
