PRESENTATION	Jan Campbell MCH Director Video and Update of AOD Perinatal Issues Jan reported where we are as to the progress with this perinatal program and share the video that was made by Dr. Chasnoff’s group. As of next month will have been 2 years screening all pregnant women in SLO County for the use of drugs, alcohol and tobacco during pregnancy. We have screened approximately 1600 women in the last 2 years, which is just about half of the birth rate in our county. 18 of the 20 providers are participating in the screening. Alcohol is the number choice of drug used by pregnant women. Compared to spinal bifida, down syndrome, and HIV, FAS is the second highest birth defect, which is totally preventable. What are the learning disabilities for the children with FAS or FASD? Why do you think there is such a resistance from the medical schools to put this information in the textbooks?
