| STATE NET NEGOTIATED AMOUNT (NNA) AND COUNTY BUDGET | Kim Miramon asked if there were any questions in regards to the email that Star sent out to members. Lots of changes occurring from State. Programs now funded with realignment dollars. AB-109 Public Safety Realignment is effective October 1, 2011. State prisoners will be released to local Counties, then to County jails or sent to Probation. Prisoners in need of DAS services will receive referrals. We will receive 3 full time positions, as well as more positions to Probation and Sheriff's Dept. Ken says Sheriff's Dept is already making modifications to the jail, more expansion done next year. Judges have received training. DAS will have funding for 24 beds, 4-week stay in sober living. Additional funding expected next year. This is for non-violent, non-serious, non-sexual offenders. We have received a grant for adult treatment collaborative court. Process before the BOS for ¾ time DAS specialist, and one full time for Mental Health. A budget update will be presented later when more information has been received. | | |

HSC #11805 states, “Each county may have an advisory board on alcohol and other drug problems appointed by the board of supervisors. The advisory board may be independent, be under the jurisdiction of another health-related or human services advisory board established pursuant to any provision of state law, or have the same membership as that other advisory board.” HSC #117521 gives definitions, see handout. It was suggested that DAAB members attend Board of Supervisors meetings. Maryanne suggested DAAB members become more pro-active. Ken suggested inviting legislative assistants to attend DAAB meetings. Frank suggested creating a “tip” sheet every meeting or two, to present to BOS. | COMMITTEE REPORTS | <p><u>Prevention:</u> Ken states Operation Safe Streets was held in Paso Robles last month. This was a multi-agency operation working every weekend to help prevent crime. There were 65 arrests, 48 tickets and 312 stops. Aurora states that presentation was made on the SAFE program to the Templeton School Site Council. Principal will be sending to the Board of Trustees.
