WELCOME & INTRODUCTIONS	Chair Jason Reed called the meeting to order at 12:09PM. Guest and potential new board member, Clint Weirick, was introduced		
PUBLIC COMMENT	Jason gave handout from SLO County Department of Social Services, Child Welfare Services on child abuse and neglect referral statistics. Number one contributing factor for referral is domestic violence, #2 is alcohol abuse, #3 Meth abuse and #4 is marijuana abuse. Also discussed the article in New Times magazine on alcohol decoys. REVIEW OF MINUTES	Approval of November meeting minutes was deferred to January 2011 meeting, as a quorum was not met.	Deferred to January 2011 meeting.	
SPECIAL SUB-COMMITTEE REPORTS	<p>Sign up sheets were displayed for members to sign up. Will be placed out again next month to have absent members sign up. Jason states members are to participate in committees as noted in DAAB By-laws. Jason requested that all Chairs of the Committees present written goals and objectives for the next meeting.</p> <p><u>Prevention</u>- Tom to meet with Prevention team and will bring update to next meeting. Aurora says Templeton High School would like education forum to speak to parents.</p> <p><u>Legislative</u>-Harlan would like to meet sometime in January with the analysts from offices of Katcho Achajidian and Sam Blakeslee. Harlan would like members to become aware of DAAB relevance in community. He will keep DAAB informed on State, County and Federal legislative issues. Aurora states that Ron Cuff from the Drug Free California Program (Aurora not sure of name) will fly people from Santa Barbara up to Sacramento when legislation meetings are being held. Aurora to give Harlan email address for Ron. Guest Clint Weirick asked if the legislative committee's main focus was on state legislative affairs only or on Federal affairs also. Harlan suggests any members hearing of pending National legislation, to let him know. At this point the legislative committee will be State oriented only.</p> <p><u>Treatment and Recovery</u>-Maryanne was unable to be at the meeting, however, Chair Jason Reed presented her written Goals and Objectives for the committee to the group. <u>Education</u>-John Lovern discussed two primary strategies for the committee: to provide education to the DAAB members on AOD issues and to provide educational institutions (e.g. Hancock, Cuesta, Cal Poly) with information and resource assistance.</p>	Written Goals and Objectives to be furnished for each committee	

CONFIRMATION OF PREVENTIVE HEALTH GRANT COMMITTEE MEMBERS	Harry Sharp will retain position of Chair for this committee, with Aurora William as alternate. Work begins in January. Grant requests are due end of January for review and recommendations. Funding for this grant comes from National tobacco settlement and County community development block grant funding.		
DAAB MEMBERSHIP	Maryanne was unable to attend meeting. She will be available in January for interviews of potential DAAB members. Those present discussed members' absences. A letter is to be sent to all members not present at this meeting asking if still interested in continuing as a board member and if so, which committee they would like to commit to. DAAB currently has 4 openings for members. One interview to be held today after meeting. Star has received 2 contacts inquiring about a position. Public service announcements have been placed in the Tribune. Aurora suggested notifying Cal Poly FNL, also notify all school principals to send information home with students. Also suggested that a flyer be sent to various organizations/groups to be placed in newsletters. Jason suggested John Lovern send flyer out to staff at Hancock College. Aurora asked for a half sheet flyer on DAAB to be handed out to members next month to aid in recruitment of new members.	Flyer to be handed out at January 2011 meeting.	
STATE NET NEGOTIATED AMOUNT (NNA) AND COUNTY BUDGET	Star states the County budget process has started as of today 12/16/10, needs to be in by February 3, 2011. Health Agency Budget to be reduced by 10%. Unions negotiating 3% raise from previous year. By mid January a "cut" list will be developed including 10% cut. The list will be ready for the January 2011 DAAB meeting. \$200,000 is just Drug and Alcohol Services division other half of Prop. 36 program being dropped. Aurora asked about any pending grants. Star states a \$170,000 grant request has been submitted and has been placed in the budget for the other half of Proposition 36 program replacement/drug court funding. A second grant possibility for Co-occurring Disorders in the amount of \$125,000 per year is due February 3, 2011. The County is going forward with the Drug Medi-Cal applications for outpatient clinical services. Mental Health Medi-Cal will pay for treatment of Co-Occurring Disorders clients.
