<b>BOARD MEMBERS RENEWAL OF APPOINTMENT</b>	Need Board of Supervisors approval for re-appointment of Reed and Palm, has been placed on BOS agenda for July. Harry Sharp has stated he will be stepping down as a DAAB member. He has been asked to submit resignation letter.		
<b>STATE NET NEGOTIATED AMOUNT (NNA) AND COUNTY BUDGET</b>	<p>Kimberly Miramon presented information on State Net Negotiated amount and County Budget. Seven positions lost (projected) in Behavioral Health. Positions added from new grants. Net effect: loss of 1.25 FTE positions. Accomplishments: Residential treatment beds up from 5 to 13, increase in number of admissions to Drug Court by 54%, DEJ increased fee collection by \$17,700, completion rate increased from 49% to 52%. Fiscal year 2011-2012 goals: obtain drug Medi-Cal certification, implement new Federal grant for providing services for drug-affected children, continue implementation of Anasazi. Discussion of options to counter cutbacks. Board letter to the BOS or pressure applied as individuals. .05 position for Perinatal and 1 FTE for FNL were designated for advocacy. “Sin” tax to pay for them. Carol proposed a motion for drafting a letter of support to BOS for retaining Perinatal and FNL positions. Board voted and passed motion. Motion made by Carol for board exploration of revenue generation thru conditional use permits.
