Question: Does Public Works have a list of approved landscape architects and/or preferred landscape architects?

Answer: Public Works does not have a list of approved landscape architects. Consultants should team with landscape architects with native plant experience.

Question: What is Public Work's anticipated level of effort to support the consultant team in conducting fieldwork and supporting other technical work?

Answer: At this time, there is no anticipated minimum level of support from County staff. Consultants should propose to complete the work effort independently. Consultants should be aware that Public Works staff will be very involved with the project team throughout plan development in order to help meet the tight deadlines.
