Are small electric powered boats acceptable?

We anticipate that this will be possible, though we do not have the permit as of yet.

What depth is considered the deepest part of the lagoon?

Also, please refer to the bathymetric survey that is attached to the RFP.

Does the project begin at the walking bridge at the end of Aloha and go all the way to the Lakeside Dr. Bridge? Just to be clear on the starting and ending point.

The project is from the flapgates to Aloha Place and from the flapgates to the open area of Meadow Creek and from the flapgates to Lakeside Drive. Please refer to the exhibit in the RFP.

The project is to be completed in 15 working days from the notice to proceed. When do you anticipate needing to start the project?

We anticipate the project to begin as soon as we can after we get environmental permits. We anticipate the notice to proceed to be issued in early to mid December.

Weather: What happens if it is raining? Does the project simply get extended for the amount of days delayed due to rain?

Yes.

Is this a Prevailing Wage project? If so, does it qualify as a landscape maintenance labor, deckhand for marine areas, other?

Yes. Landscape Maintenance Labor is our guess.
