6. New Business:

Draft Template for Annual Report- Committee Reports to be combined and used in Annual Report. Drafts are due by the 1st of January.

Jill Heuer and Joyce Heddleson recommended a new Board Member candidate: Dr. Martin Bragg.

7. Director's Report: State Updates

Anne Robin introduced Leah DeRose, our new Patient's Rights Advocate to the Board. Leah DeRose comes from Juvenile Hall and reports to Greg Vickery. Welcome Leah!

State Report: CBHDA- Working on two major initiatives, 1915b waiver and the 1115b waiver for mental health Medi-Cal and Drug Medi-Cal services.

Psychiatric Hospital in Templeton- 20 Beds each for Kids, Youth, Adults and Seniors. Would accept Medi-Cal for all except for Adults. The Psychiatric Care Facility would continue to operate the same. It will give us 40 beds for Youth/Kids. Will be located across from Twin Cities Hospital. The projected completion date is 2017. There will be a Templeton community meeting held tomorrow, November 20, 2014 at 7:00pm

Withdrawal Management- Has really taken off. Katie Dolezal has seen double the clients.

Psychiatrists- Had some queries. Still have three applications and another that just applied. We continue to recruit.

8. Presentation: Children's Services- Patty Ford.

Patty Ford gave an over-view of all Youth Services we provide:

- Clinic Sites: Provide Individual, Family, Group, Crisis, Intervention, Med Management, Intensive Day Treatment Program. One on Grand and one at Vicente. 10 kids capacity.
- Safe Sites: Provide two in South County(Oceano and Nipomo) and two in SLO. Coordinates with other agencies to provide clothing, food and shelter along with mental health services. Eric Burt works to coordinate in SLO
- Provide Mental Health Services at Juvenile Hall. Currently we have a half-time position available. Provide Risk Assessment as they come in. Lots of Crisis Intervention, Staff are meeting with kids and are very active, not in their offices. Very collaborative program with Probation.
- Loma Vista and Mesa View- Abused children. Provide services for Trauma. Focus on sexual abuse. Referral through Managed Care. We get calls from Victim Witness and parents.
- Martha's Place- Services for 0-5year olds,
- Katie-A- State mandated program. Need to have open Child Welfare Case and Medi-Cal. Department of Social Services added DSS Net. Currently about 108 kids in program.
