**STORM RELATED INFORMATION ON COUNTY OES WEB SITE**

**SAN LUIS OBISPO, CA, December 23, 2010** – During the recent storms the county of San Luis Obispo provided helpful information through its Web site. However the information is provided by different county departments on their various Web pages and in some cases was difficult to find. In order to help streamline access to storm and other emergency related information the county Office of Emergency Services (OES) Web site has been updated to simplify the process.

The updated OES Web site contains links to resources such as flooding health advisory and clean up guidance, current beach advisories, county road and state highway information, emergency safety information related to the Arroyo Grande Creek levee, PG&E power outage information, real time stream flow information, and many other helpful sites and services provided by the county and other agencies. It also provides information on which of the linked county departments provides the various related services and includes contact information for them.
