Preliminary Damage Assessment Information Needed

SAN LUIS OBISPO, CA, December 28, 2010 – The San Luis Obispo County Office of Emergency Services is requesting residents and businesses that incurred damages during the recent storms to report such damages. The information will be compiled and given to state and federal authorities to help determine if the county might qualify for a federal disaster declaration.

Residents and business are requested to provide their name, contact phone number, address, and a brief overview of the damages incurred, including repair costs if known.
