Local implementation

- Who will be affected in SLO County?
 - ~ 40,000+ uninsured
 - Medical Eligible - ~18,000 to 25,000
 - Exchange subsidy eligible - ~14,000
 - Non-citizens - ~7,000
- Available plans in SLO
 - Blue Shield PPO, Anthem PPO
 - Premiums for silver plan -- 40 yr old single
 - \$314-\$326/mo; subsidies reduce to \$46 - \$326


