CALIFORNIA NEW MEDI-CAL SECTION 1115 WAIVER

*Moving Forward
Collaboratively*

- ⊙ “California’s Bridge to Reform” Demonstration
- ⊙ “Health Care Coverage Initiative” is now “Coverage Expansion and Enrollment Demonstration” (CEED)
- ⊙ Approved from November 1, 2010 to October 31, 2015



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Goals

- ⊙ Expand coverage to more uninsured adults;
- ⊙ Help to preserve the safety net;
- ⊙ Improve care coordination for vulnerable populations; and
- ⊙ Promote public hospital delivery system transformation.



EXPANDED COVERAGE THROUGH CEED

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- ⊙ Transition plan to Medi-Cal in 2014
- ⊙ Requirements for covering 0-133% FPL eligibles
 - ⊙ Benchmark-like benefits – probably Medi-Cal
 - ⊙ Due process for eligibility and benefit access
 - ⊙ Network adequacy standards
 - ⊙ Contract with at least one FQHC at PPS rates
 - ⊙ Out of network hospital emergency care
 - ⊙ Mental health and substance abuse parity rules will apply according to forthcoming Medicaid rules
- ⊙ Similar requirements for 133 – 200% FPL eligibles



EXPANDED COVERAGE THROUGH CEED

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- ⊙ Key to CEED is “Certified Public Expenditures” (CPE’s)
- ⊙ State will not be putting up funds
- ⊙ Federal government will match local, non-federal, non-matched funds
- ⊙ Examples:
 - ⊙ County funding for medically indigent program
 - ⊙ MHSA, Tobacco Settlement
 - ⊙ Other local spending



CHALLENGES

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- ⊙ Political changes – state officials and federal
- ⊙ Slow state start up
- ⊙ Unknown rules and timelines
- ⊙ Cost of coverage and number of potential enrollees
- ⊙ No coverage for undocumented
- ⊙ Enrollment processes
- ⊙ Administrative costs
- ⊙ Mental health and substance abuse parity
- ⊙ Jail and prison matching funds
