SLO COUNTY LIHP UPDATE

Recommend NO LIHP for SLO

Staff recommends County NOT proceed with establishing a LIHP

Why not?

- High risk of net expenditures for dual CMSP/LIHP programs to require increased local funding
 - Optimistic scenario requires an additional \$500K of GFS for first year



SLO COUNTY LIHP UPDATE

Recommend NO LIHP for SLO

- July 2012 implementation date not likely due to remaining infrastructure development
 - Complex IT development required for data reporting and enrollment system, plus contracting with providers, the state, and TPA
- Life of program would be less than 18 months
 - Starting Jan. 2014, LIHP as well as CMSP enrollees will transition to newly expanded Medi-Cal program or an insurance exchange and both programs will shut down

Project Takeaways

- BSCF funding enabled us to conduct a detailed examination of our MIA needs and system
- Strengthened collaborative relationships with stakeholders



SLO COUNTY LIHP UPDATE

Next Steps

- Follow up meetings with Board members
- Prepare for transition:
 - Continue to work with CenCal Health and DSS to prepare for CMSP transition to Medi-Cal in 2014
- Budget planning:
 - State will take back MIA funding
- MIA care after 2014:
 - Health Reform does not include undocumented who will continue to seek care at community clinics and ERs
