Dear Mr. McKenzie,

Thank you for the opportunity to respond to the Excelaron Project.

On July 11, 2011, at the South County Regional Center in Arroyo Grande, you stated that Excelaron traffic on Huasna Rd. Would be limited to vehicles no larger than a pickup truck. All larger trucks destined for the Excelaron project would be required to use the access from Hwy. 166.

My questions to you are:

1. Will these restrictions be a part of the Conditions for a use permit, and how will the County Then enforce violations of the truck restrictions?
2. Since propane delivery trucks (and other service/delivery trucks) are not owned or controlled By Excelaron, will these trucks also fall under the same restrictions/limitations?
3. If a resident of the Huasna area observes a violation of the truck restrictions/limitations, to whom do we report these violations and what action will the County then take?
