The County is updating the 2010 Fair Housing Plan / Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice. The United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires the County and its cities to have a Fair Housing Plan in order to receive funds from following programs:

- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
- HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) and the American Dream Down Payment Initiative (ADDI)
- Emergency shelter Grant (ESG)

The Plan will be a part of the County's Consolidated Plan/Action Plan, which will guide the spending of the federal funds from HUD. The County will prepare the Fair Housing Plan for consideration by the Board of Supervisors. Anyone may comment on the Fair Housing Plan before the decision-makers take final action. The public hearing on the Fair Housing Plan and the Consolidated Plan/Action Plan will be announced via a mailed and published notice.
