1. **What's Available:** Clean Up and Housekeeping Updates to the Growth Management Ordinance, Title 26 of the County Code.
2. **What is an Ordinance Update?**
The County periodically updates ordinances to respond to outdated references and proposes text revisions which further simplify and clarify the purpose of the ordinance.
3. **How is the County updating the Ordinance?**
On May 15, 2007 the San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors conducted their annual review of the County Growth Rate and Authorization of Amendments to Title 26, Growth Management Ordinance. At that meeting the Board of Supervisors authorized planning staff to develop future ordinance amendments related to the clean up of outdated references and information, and simplification of the Growth Management Ordinance for better understanding and efficiency.
4. **What are the steps, and where is the proposed update in the process?**
 - ✓ Public Review Draft (March 3, 2008).
 - ✓ Public Input (on-going)
 - ✓ Public Hearings - County Planning Commission - April 10, 2008.
 - ✓ Public Hearings - County Board of Supervisors - May 13, 2008 - continued hearing to August 12, 2008.
 - ✓ Public Hearings - County Board of Supervisors - August 12, 2008 - updates approved.
5. **How can I review and comment on the draft?**
Public participation is welcome throughout the process. Early comments submitted in writing are preferred. Interested persons and groups may also wish to attend future public meetings and speak for or against the changes.
