We are property owners in San Luis Obispo County, and as such we are voicing our opposition to this project. For reasons beyond our control we are unable to attend the public hearings on Feb. 4 and 5, however we want you to know we are concerned for the public's safety if trains carrying highly toxic and explosive crude oil are allowed to journey through our communities on their way to a rail terminal at the Phillips 66 refinery. Devastating train derailments have occurred in other parts of the country, and although the pollutant is different, we do not want to find ourselves having to deal with the devastating results that have and are happening in Flint, Michigan.
