My concern for the public health/safety of the children I teach in Paso Robles is first and foremost, but my professional background as a hydrologist compels me to advise you this project could be disastrous and irreversible for the environment. Such a large portion of the train tracks lie adjacent to the Salinas River and it would be fool hearty and short-sighted to jeopardize a water resource in the midst of California's prolonged drought. **As your constituent, I urge you to vote no on this project!** I will be following this issue very closely and hope that you vote to reject this proposal.
