Dear Ms. Arlin-Genet and Mr. Wilson:

The Phillips 66 Santa Maria Refinery (SMR) is providing herein an EIR Mitigation Plan (the "Plan") for the SMR Crude Throughput Increase Project (Project). The Project involves no construction but will result in a 10% increase in crude throughput. The Phillips 66 Plan addresses Project Impacts identified in the San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisor's Conditions of Approval (Resolution No. 2013-35, dated February 26, 2013) after consideration of the Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR), dated October 2012.

Since there are two lead agencies with responsibility for different aspects of this Project, two summary tables were developed to facilitate this division of responsibilities. Each table includes a list of mitigation measures included in the Conditions of Approval that is segregated by agency assigned oversight responsibilities in Resolution No. 2013-35 and the FEIR. In addition to the Conditions of Approval from Exhibit B of the Resolution, the table includes a brief summary of Phillips 66 proposed mitigation measure with details of the Plan provided in the attachments.
