

Dear Planning Commissioners,

Our son is an incoming freshman at Cal Poly University in San Luis Obispo, and we are extremely concerned about the proposed admission of oil trains onto the railroad tracks that travel through and around the university campus. Any leakage of tar sands oil would pose an immediate threat to the health and safety of students and local residents, and a large spill could result in a mile-wide blast zone.

We are writing to ask you to deny the application of the Phillips 66 Santa Maria Refinery in Nipomo, which seeks to upgrade its facility to allow tar sands oil processing. As the parents of a Cal Poly student, we consider ourselves a valuable part of the San Luis Obispo community, and we wish to make our concerns clear as we urge you to place the health and safety of **all** our students, now and in the future, above the profits of one company.

Please do not let the many voices of your community remain unheard; we implore you to keep San Luis Obispo a place where our students can thrive without the constant threat of polluted water and fire hazards. I strongly encourage you to listen carefully to the needs and desires of your community and recognize that the most logical decision is a denial of this project.
